



**Ubon Ratchathani University Announcement**  
**Application for International Students, Undergraduate, 2020 Academic Year**

Ubon Ratchathani University invites international students to submit applications for the 2020 academic year. There are 177 open seats for international students. The details are as follows:

**1. Admission Requirements**

1.1 Applicants must not hold Thai citizenship or Thai permanent resident status and have received a high school certificate or its equivalence recognized by the respective Ministry of Education. Applicants must submit their certificate of completion from a high school or its equivalence from an American educational system, the British educational system, or an educational system of a specified country. The university reserves the rights to approve whether or not the qualification is acceptable.

1.2 Applicants must be able to communicate in Thai or English and achieve a satisfactory score in a standardized Thai/English proficiency test prior to the admission to the program.

Students applying for an English taught program without a satisfactory score in a standardized English proficiency test such as TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS, TU-GET, or CU-TEP must take a test specified by the program of study.

Students applying for a Thai, or Thai and English, taught program without a satisfactory score in a standardized Thai proficiency test must take Thai training courses, pass the test specified by the training program, and acquire the necessary Thai knowledge and skills as required by the respective program of study. The training arrangements as well as contents are managed by the university.

1.3 Students entering a Health Science or Science and Technology program must have completed high school or its equivalence in a Science and Mathematics program.

1.4 Applicants must not have been imprisoned by the Supreme Court for a criminal offense with the exception of sentences for offenses committed negligently or minor offenses.

1.5 Applicants must not have been dismissed from an educational institution for disorderly misconduct.

1.6 Applicants must meet other specific requirements by the respective faculties and programs.

1.7 Applicants can apply to only one academic program at Ubon Ratchathani University at a time.
